The Oregon Area Fire/EMS District is currently seeking individuals to fill immediate vacancies for the position of Intern. An internship is a three (3) year commitment where the intern will be assigned a shift consisting of a 24 hour on and 48 hour off rotation. This is a live in the fire station position, where selected candidates will stay for the duration of the internship. Depending on the qualifications of the candidate, hired Interns will be expected to obtain certification as a State of Wisconsin firefighter I and II, as well as obtain and maintain a State of Wisconsin Licensure as an Emergency Medical Technician Basic (EMT-B). Additionally, Interns will attend classes to obtain an Associates degree in either Fire Science or as a Paramedic Technician.
